CHAPERONE INFORMATION (PAGE 1 OF 3)

Chaperones are integral to the success of the Asian American Youth Leadership Conference. In an effort to help you prepare for the conference, the planning committee has outlined the responsibilities of the chaperones. **Each school must send one chaperone per up to 15 students.**

Pre-Conference:

- Meet with your students prior to the conference to review conference expectations and answer any questions about the conference.
- Remind all students to dress appropriately. Students will receive a conference string bag at registration, which they are expected to wear/carry during the conference. The AAYLC string bag will be a crucial element for forming groups and teams.

Day of the Conference – Boarding the Bus:

- Ensure all students are dressed appropriately. Remind students that all participants will be required to wear/carry the AAYLC STRING BAG during the conference.
- Review conference expectations one more time.

Arrival at Portland Community College Sylvania Campus:

- Enter campus off Capitol Highway and turn onto 49th Street.
- Follow driveway and drop students off at the **TriMet Bus Stop area**. A student ambassador will greet and lead you and your students to the designated area for breakfast. Plan to arrive by 8 a.m. so students can enjoy breakfast.
- Pick up location will be the same as drop-off location. Pick up time is 3:15 p.m.
- Please ensure that your bus is clearly marked for your school/district at pick-up, as there will be many buses at the same location at end of the day. Buses may line up and park along the driveway while waiting for students to board.



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- Student Ambassadors will greet and lead your students to the designated area to have breakfast while **the chaperone checks-in at the registration table** to reduce congestion. **When you check in at the registration table, you will need to submit an updated list of conference participants and report the number of students attending.**

NO STUDENTS will be allowed at the registration table.

- **Remind students that their NAME TAGS, STRING BAGS, AND WRISTBANDS must be worn and be visible throughout the conference.**
- Chaperones will be given a sign with the name of your school so students can locate you, and you can use it to gather them together.
- Breakfast will be served in the designated area.
- Opening program will be held in the Gymnasium.
- Students will be divided into groups and teams after the keynote presentation. The groups and teams will be randomly assigned and will usually not have people from the same school. This will be organized through color coded string bags and wristbands. There will be a total of 16 to 20 teams. Depending on the number of attendees, there will be between 20-25 people per team.
- Chaperones will play an important role in helping with crowd control and informational functions. You will be assigned a team with whom you will travel throughout the day to ensure that students are where they belong. You will also help direct students and clarify for them what they should do. You may or may not be with students from your school. Please help all students to get the most out of the conference by encouraging them to participate in the activities.

Your tasks will include:

1. Provide assistance to students as they participate in activities.
2. Encourage students to fully participate in the activities and support those who need a little help.
3. Be ready at the end of the conference with your school sign so that students from your school can find you again.

- There will be two lunch sessions.
- Lunch will be served in the designated area.

Conference Closing Program:

- After the session in the afternoon, chaperones will accompany students back to the gymnasium and be seated as promptly as possible.
